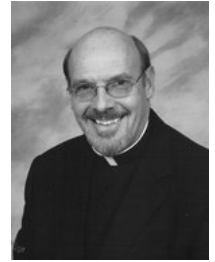

Dear Parishioners of St. Catherine,

The question asked of me most often as I prepared to retire from the pastorate of St. Anthony, Pewaukee, last month was: "What will you do?" It was something of a relief, but more seriously a great joy, to be able to respond: "I will be serving as one of the Assisting Priests at St. Catherine of Alexandria, one of seven parishes without a resident priest in our archdiocese."



I sincerely welcome the invite of your Parish Director, Debbie Hintz, and the archbishop's blessing, to join my classmate and friend, Fr. Dick Mirsberger, at your parish. Offering Mass, preaching God's Word and celebrating the Sacraments have been the substance of my priestly ministry over the past 44 years.

I left home in Kenosha at the age of 14 to begin studies for priesthood at St. Francis Seminary, Milwaukee. I was ordained by Archbishop William E. Cousins on May 28th, 1966. I have been privileged to enjoy a variety of careers as a diocesan priest.

After three years as an Assistant Pastor at Immaculate Conception Parish, West Bend, I was asked to develop the Department of Field Education or pastoral formation at St. Francis Seminary. In 1976, I also became the Vice-Rector of the Seminary. From 1979 to 1983, I served as the Executive Secretary of the Priests Personnel Board before becoming Pastor of St. Mark Parish, Kenosha.

In 1995, I was named Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Racine. From 1998 to 2004, I served as the Vicar for Clergy and Vicar General of the archdiocese. In 2004, I began a six-year term as Pastor of St. Anthony on the Lake, Pewaukee, where I retired from administration last month.

I continue to make my home in Pewaukee, close to my recently widowed sister, and near one of my two married nieces. God has blessed me abundantly with a wonderful family, many friends, and the privilege to serve throughout the archdiocese. Now you know something about me. I look forward to getting to know you as we pray together in thanksgiving for all that God has given us.
