**LITURGY NOTES**

**Community** – My thoughts and prayers this week have surrounded the reality of “community” and all that it means. A number of phrases have been running through my head: “it takes a village to raise a child”, “no one is an island” and “ask and you shall receive” which is from today’s Gospel.

For me, the main theme of this Sunday’s readings is our interdependence on God and one another. The Gospel tells the story of a friend going to the neighbor’s at midnight asking for three loaves of bread (the proverbial running to the neighbor’s for a cup of sugar).

In any given week, each of us encounters people in need. This week, those that I have encountered in need has been a somewhat larger number than most weeks and some needs have been more serious than usual. Also in any given week, each of us ourselves is in need in some way. Sometimes others come to us looking for bread, sometimes we go in search of bread.

Vatican II tells us that the Liturgy, Sunday Worship, is the source and summit of our week. This somewhat heady phrase really means that we are invited to bring these needs to worship (the summit) and gain the strength from our worship (the source) to make it through our struggles.

Christ’s instruction “ask and you shall receive” tells us to believe in God and one another, to be “community”. There was a man stranded on his rooftop during a flood. Three times, people in boats came by and offered to take him to safety. “No, no, I believe in God and God will save me.” Eventually the man drowned, went to heaven and asked God, “Why didn’t you save me?” God answered, “I sent help three times!”
